

INFORMATION ABOUT THE MEDICAL REVIEW FOR VISAS

Types of Visas:

A) Immigration Visa

The medical examination is different, depending on the age of the applicant:

- < 2 years old:** Medical Examination
Review of vaccination card
- 2-14 years old:** Medical Examination
Review of vaccination card
Mantoux Test (tuberculosis screening). After the test is conducted, a further reading after 48 hours is required. This will have an additional cost of 10 Euros.
- ≥ 15 years old:** Medical Examination
Review of vaccination card
Blood analysis for the testing of Syphilis (VDRL)
Chest X-Ray

Requirements of vaccinations according to the age of the applicant:

Vaccination	Age	Observations
DTP/DTaP/DT	From 2 months to 6 years	
Td/Tdap	> 7 years	Second dose after 1 month, third dose after 6 months
Polio (IPV/OPV)	From 2 months to 17 years	
MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)	> 1 year and births after 1957	Second dose after 1 month
Rotavirus	From 2 months to 5 years	
Hib (Haemophilus I, Type B)	From 2 to 59 months (5 years)	
Hepatitis A	From 12 to 23 months	
Hepatitis B	< 18 years	
Meningococcus	From 11 to 18 years	
Human papillomavirus		Is not necessary
Varicella	> 1 year	Second dose after 2 months
Zoster		Is not necessary
Pneumococcus	From 2 to 59 months (5 years) and > 65 years	
Influenza	> 50 years	Not fall (flu) season

Documentation that must be given to Reception:

- 3 passport-size **photographs**. In the case of minors under the age of 15 years, only 2 photographs are needed.
- Original **passport**.
- **Letter from the Embassy**, which has the address of our clinic.

After the medical examination is completed, the cost can be paid for in Administration. The cost is **165 Euros for adults and 80 Euros for minors of 14 years of less**. In the case of Mantoux testing for minors 14 years or less, there is **an additional cost of 10 Euros**. These costs should be paid for **in cash and in one single payment**.

After payment is complete, you will be directed to Sanatorio Nuestra Señora del Rosario to complete your chest X-Ray. This center is accredited by the American Embassy to perform the test. A prescription will be given, on which the photograph of the applicant will be attached, with the address of the center and a map for easy location.

The results should be collected in person the day after the examination after 12pm in the case of individuals older than 15 years, and after 48 hours in the case of minors of 15 years of less.

Results can be collected from our clinic only from the hours of 12pm – 6pm.

In the case that results cannot be collected by an individual in person, authorization can be given **in writing** for another person to collect the results.

B) Fiancee Visa:

The only difference is that a review of a vaccination card is not needed, as it will be done in the United States.

NOTE: THE MEDICAL EXAMINATION WILL BE VALID FOR SIX MONTHS.
